

**WARREN COUNTY ELECTORAL BOARD MEETING
November 7, 2018**

The Electoral Board of Warren County met on Wednesday, November 7, 2018 to Canvas the November 6, 2018 General and Special Elections. Members in attendance were Linda Taylor, Vice Chairman; Lee Bowen, Secretary. Carol Tobin, Director of Elections/General Registrar was available to assist when needed. Bill Hammack, Chairman was not in attendance.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. and the Canvas of the November 6, 2018 General and Special Elections was the first order of business. Members present began their review of the results of the Election. At 10:00 a.m. they moved to open the Provisional Ballot Meeting. No members of the public or voters were present for this meeting. Carol Tobin, General Registrar, indicated that research was still ongoing for the provisional votes that were cast. There were 19 provisional votes that were cast; one of which was because of not presenting with appropriate Photo ID. The Board decided to recess the provisional ballot meeting at this time and until the General Registrar had completed the necessary research.

The canvas of the Election continued with the review of all the precinct results. The results were verified and the Electoral Board recessed the meeting at 3:00 p.m.

Lee Bowen, Secretary and Linda Taylor, Vice Chairman checked in on November 8 to determine if the provisional ballot meeting could reconvene; however, it was determined that research was still ongoing and the provisional voter with no Photo ID still had until noon on Friday November 9, 2018 to present appropriate Photo ID; therefore, the Electoral Board decided to reconvene the provisional meeting on Monday November 11, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.

The Electoral Board reconvened the Provisional Ballot meeting and Canvas on Monday, November 11, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. Lee Bowen, Secretary and Linda Taylor, Vice Chairman along with Carol Tobin, Director of Elections/General Registrar were present. The research had been completed and the Board determined which provisional ballot could be counted. Of the 19 provisional ballots that were cast a total of 7 were eligible to be counted; unfortunately, the Photo ID provisional voter did not return appropriate Photo ID; therefore, that ballot could not be counted.

After the final review, Abstracts were prepared, signed and attested. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:15 a.m.
