

PARKS AND RECREATION SUSPENSION GUIDELINES

Purpose:

To establish guidelines for the suspension and discipline of park visitors and program participants once a statement requesting or warranting removal from a league, program or facility has been received for review by the Warren County Parks and Recreation Department.

All leagues, activities and facilities have their own set rules and regulations. These guidelines are only to be considered once the Warren County Parks and Recreation Department has received a written statement from an outside organization/user group or an employee of the County of Warren that requests or warrants additional measures be taken against the involved individual(s).

Other:

- Individuals involved in an incident may be subject to a probationary period of up to one (1) year. If the individual violates the Parks and Recreation Department guidelines during the probationary period, the individual may be subject to an additional suspension period of up to one (1) year.
- All suspensions = or < 6 months to be levied while season is in progress
- All incidents Subject to WCPRD Review
- Any incident in which the Police are called may result in a **MINIMUM** one (1) year suspension
- Any player ejected twice in a season will automatically be removed from league for a minimum of one (1) month.
- All ejections are subject to a two (2) year ban from all WCPRD programs and facilities.

These Suspension Guidelines DO NOT eliminate possibility of Legal Action being taken.
