

WARREN COUNTY ELECTORAL BOARD MEETING
November 6, 2019

The Electoral Board of Warren County met on Wednesday, November 6, 2019 to Canvas the November 5, 2019 General and Special Elections. Members in attendance were Marilyn King, Chairman and Lee Bowen, Secretary. Linda Taylor, Vice-Chair was unable to attend. Carol Tobin, Director of Elections/General Registrar was available to assist when needed.

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. and the Canvas of the November 5, 2019 General and Special Elections was the first order of business. Members present began their review of the results of the Election. At 10:00 a.m. they moved to open the Provisional Ballot Meeting. Carol Tobin, General Registrar, indicated that research was still ongoing for the provisional votes that were cast. There were four (4) provisional votes that were cast; two of which were cast due to not presenting with appropriate Photo ID. The Board decided to recess the provisional ballot meeting at 10:15 a.m. and until the General Registrar had completed the necessary research.

The canvas of the Election continued with the review of all the precinct results. The results were verified and the Electoral Board recessed the meeting at 3:00 p.m.

Lee Bowen, Secretary and Marilyn King, Chairman checked in on November 7, 2019 to determine if the provisional ballot meeting could reconvene; however, it was determined that research was still ongoing and the provisional voters with no Photo ID still had until noon on Friday November 8, 2019 to present appropriate Photo ID; therefore, the Electoral Board decided to reconvene the provisional meeting Friday, November 8, 2019.


The Electoral Board reconvened the Provisional Ballot meeting and Canvas on Friday, November 8, 2019 at 11:45 a.m. Lee Bowen, Secretary and Marilyn King, Chairman along with Carol Tobin, Director of Elections/General Registrar were present. Linda Taylor, Vice-Chairman was unable to attend. The research had been completed and the Board determined which provisional ballots could be counted. Of the four provisional ballots that were cast, only one was eligible to be counted; unfortunately, the Photo ID provisional voters did not return appropriate Photo ID; therefore, those ballots could not be counted.

After the final review, Abstracts were prepared, signed and attested. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:30 p.m.
